**The Feeding Kids in Care project provides opportunities for faculty and students to advance their research on the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) in settings that serve children.**

The project will facilitate collaboration by offering members a space for sharing ideas, knowledge and feedback that aids their individual publication records as well as the collective publications of the team, and assistance with collaborative external grant proposals and access to internal resources and dialogue.
