An 8-week paid summer incubator for our top student startups

Launching in Summer 2015, the Entrepreneurship @ Illinois Summer Fellowship allows our top student startup teams to spend the summer on campus with the time and resources to build prototypes, create a value proposition, test demand, research the competitive landscape, validate market size, and make progress in developing their startup ventures. Whether you are creating a technological innovation, social venture, or cultural campaign or program, this fellowship will equip you with the time, space, resources, and mentoring necessary to turn your idea into a scalable venture.

The Experience:



8-week summer program for teams of 2-4 UIUC students

June 8th – August 7th (Summer Session 2)



\$2,500 stipend per individual



Mentorship from seasoned entrepreneurs



Capacity fund for startup costs up to \$10,000 per team

By application and for necessary startup costs: prototyping, supplies, travel, etc.
