The Illinois Early Childhood Activity Program (I-CAP) seeks to advance physical activity research by developing models of physical activity measurements for preschool children, which can be used in natural environments.

The research team includes both the Urbana-Champaign and Chicago campuses and combines expertise in computer engineering, social media, kinesiology, community health, family health, neuroscience, child development, child care, health disparities, parks and recreation, and public health. The project has featured four workshops over the past two years to help integrate theoretical frameworks across disciplines.
