

# PARKING FOR ORIENTATION AND THE ACADEMIC YEAR

**Where to Park?** There are several parking options available for students during Orientation and the academic year. Most students will purchase a parking pass for the University Shuttle Lot (E14), conveniently located across from the State Farm Center (f/k/a Assembly Hall). The shuttle lot is an approximate 10 minute walk from the law building. However, students may also utilize free MTD shuttles from E14 with service near the law building. **TIP:** *Students are strongly encouraged to purchase a parking pass during August, prior to the start of the academic year, for use during Orientation and the first weeks of class.*

**Parking Meters:** There are a number of metered parking spaces located on the streets surrounding the law building and in Lot E15 located on the south side of Pennsylvania Avenue, directly across from the law building. University of Illinois metered parking spaces (designated by a Block I) may be paid by cash, [CashKey](#), or [paybyphone](#) services. Please review enforcement times located on individual parking meters. Please note: during the academic year, availability of metered parking during business hours is limited.

**Evening Parking:** For those students visiting the law building in the evening hours, free parking is available in Lot E15 (located directly across south of the law building) after 5:00 pm.

**Don't plan to bring a car to campus?** If you are not planning to utilize a car for your daily commute, the Champaign-Urbana [MTD](#) system provides easy transportation to the law building, around campus, and throughout the greater Champaign-Urbana community. In addition, bicycle racks are located on the east side of the law building for students wishing to cycle to campus.
